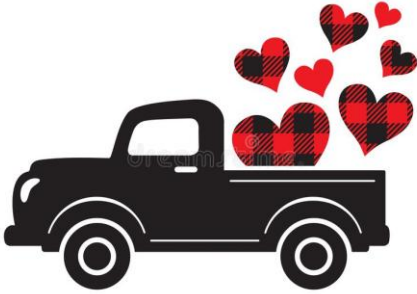

Thank you for your continued support of our school as we move into the month ahead.

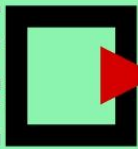

## **Cold Weather**

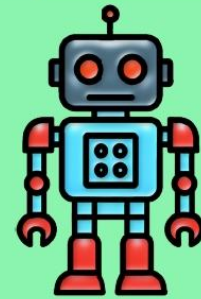
